# HOW TO USE THE POWER CONNECTION POWER GUIDE

*Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.*  
I John 5:14-15

The Power Guide is designed as a tool for study, reflection and prayer. Each prayer is written based on the model of the Lord's Prayer (see Matthew 6:9-13).

In order to maximize the use of your guide, please follow the listed instructions.

1. Set aside a few minutes each day to pray individually, with your family or prayer partner(s). Gradually build your prayer time with the Lord to at least thirty (30) to sixty (60) minutes each day. You can split up your prayer time, if necessary, and pray a few minutes in the morning and evening. You choose the time of day that is good for you. Find a comfortable place to pray and turn off any distractions. If you have small children who need most of your attention, pray the daily prayer with them. Let God's Word saturate their hearing.
2. Refer to the Prayer Petition Calendar on page 4 for the specific prayer for the day. Only pray for the prayer petition that is assigned to that day so that we are unified in our daily praying. Please do not get ahead of the prayer for the day. Before praying the "Scriptural Prayer," first read the scriptures listed for "Scripture Reading."
3. Pray the assigned prayer out loud. There is power in your verbal expression. Parents please encourage your children to pray their prayer petitions in the Children's Power Guide out loud. Youth (ages 13-17) may use the Adult Power Guide.
4. These prayers are intended to be a springboard to help you with your prayerful conversations. Trust the Holy Spirit to help you to expand upon the prayer that you are praying for the day. If you speak in tongues, please pray in tongues over each prayer petition. Relax, listen and enjoy the Lord.
5. Record any reflections, revelations, or inspiration given by the Holy Spirit in the Prayer Expectation section at the end of the Power Guide.
6. Believe that the Lord is hearing your prayer and know in your heart that you're praying will produce God's results for the prayer topic you are praying for.
7. After praying, make your daily power confession by using the Daily Power Confessions located on page 35. When you speak God's Word over your life, you activate the power of His Word to work in your life and produce God's results for your life. Expect God's Word to transform your life. I also recommend that you speak the Power Confessions over your family.
8. Enjoy your time spent with the Lord and thank you for helping to "take the world by prayer."

**Petition #1:**

**A Prayer of Preparation for the Spring Feasts**

**Scripture Reading:**

Nehemiah 9:5-15, Deuteronomy 16:1-12

**Reflections of the Heart:**

Remember that we are blessed that God has added followers of His Son, Jesus Christ, to His family, to be joined with the children of Abraham, giving us the right to meet with God at His appointed times, just as our Lord and Savior did while He walked the earth.

**Scriptural Prayer:**

Father God, we thank You for desiring to spend time with us during the festivals that You decreed must be a permanent law for Your people, to be observed from generation to generation wherever they live. We reflect, during these appointed times, on what great love You have demonstrated to Your people. Thank You, Jesus, for becoming the perfect sacrifice for our sins with Your own blood, so that we are able to come into the presence of the living God and worship Him. Creator of the heavens and earth and everything therein, we praise You, because You have visited and redeemed Your people. Abraham, Isaac and Jacob are our ancestors, and Christ Himself was an Israelite as far as His human nature is concerned. Christ is our Lord, our resurrected Savior, who rules over everything and is worthy of eternal praise. We love You and we appreciate You. We praise You, Lord God of Israel, as You alone do such wonderful things.

Holy Father, You redeemed Your chosen people out of the house of slavery in Egypt and declared them to be Your own people and Yourself as their God. You have not changed, Abba Father, for many years later, at the same time of year during the celebration of remembrance of their physical freedom, You provided spiritual freedom. You loved the world so much that You gave Your only begotten Son, as Redeemer, sacrificed on the altar of the cross, freeing all believers from slavery to sin. As we come together during the springtime of the year, we desire to prepare ourselves to meet with You to celebrate the Passover, the Festival of Unleavened Bread and the Celebration of the First Harvest. We will examine ourselves and confess our sins to You, that we may be forgiven. In our homes, we and our families vow to serve You alone. We will carefully examine our homes, just as we examine ourselves, to be certain that there is no unclean thing that might incite demonic oppression. As You have decreed, we will remove all yeast from our homes as we prepare to celebrate the Festival of Unleavened Bread, not with the old bread of wickedness and evil, but with the new bread of sincerity and truth. And when we come into Your presence, Lord, we will not appear before You without an offering.

As we search the Scriptures, Holy Spirit, lead us to the portions of God's Word which will instruct us in preparing for the Spring Feasts. Bring to our remembrance areas in our lives which require transformation in order to be cleansed of sin or idolatry. Inspire in us greater appreciation for the blessings which have been bestowed upon us. Father, bless our families and enlarge our territories so that we may have even more to bring back into Your Kingdom. Father, meet with us as we celebrate the Spring Feasts to honor You. We look forward to celebrating with You during this exciting time.

Redeeming Father, hear us from heaven where You live; and when You hear, forgive us when we are ignorant about preparing ourselves to meet You at Your appointed times. Forgive our sinfulness when we desire to hold on to our old ways and are reluctant to follow Your precepts which are new to us. Forgive those who choose not to celebrate Your festivals or those who are unable or unwilling to bring offerings to You. Lord, forgive me for ***(list any sins that you have committed)***. Holy Spirit, remind us all of those we need to forgive and help us to be quick to forgive. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. ***(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to show you names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He shows you, say aloud, "I forgive name of person(s)." Now, trust the Lord to heal any wounds in your soul caused by unforgiveness.)***

Heavenly Father, help us to not yield to temptation; but deliver us from the evil one.

O Lord, God of Israel, there is no god like You in all of heaven above or on the earth below. You keep Your covenant and show unfailing love to all who walk before You in wholehearted devotion. We praise Your Name with singing and we honor You with thanksgiving. Our hearts are confident in You, O God; no wonder we sing Your praises. Almighty God, we will always proclaim what You have done. King of kings, Lord of lords, we sing praises to the God of Jacob. In the mighty Name of Jesus, Amen!
