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## HOW TO USE THE POWER CONNECTION POWER GUIDE

*Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.*

1 John 5:14-15

The Power Guide is designed as a tool for study, reflection and prayer. Each prayer is written based on the model of the Lord's Prayer (see Matthew 6:9-13).

In order to maximize the use of your guide, please follow the listed instructions.

1. Set aside a few minutes each day to pray individually, with your family or prayer partner(s). Gradually build your prayer time with the Lord to at least thirty (30) to sixty (60) minutes each day. You can split up your prayer time, if necessary, and pray a few minutes in the morning and evening. You choose the time of day that is good for you. Find a comfortable place to pray and turn off any distractions. If you have small children who need most of your attention, pray the daily prayer with them. Let God's Word saturate their hearing.
2. Refer to the Prayer Topic Calendar on page (4) for the specific prayer for the day. Only pray for the prayer topic that is assigned to that day so that we are unified in our daily praying. Please do not get ahead of the prayer for the day. Before praying the "Scriptural Prayer," first read the scriptures listed for "Scripture Reading."
3. Pray the assigned prayer out loud. There is power in your verbal expression. Parents please encourage your children to pray their prayer topics in the Children's Power Guide out loud. Youth (ages 13-17) may use the Adult Power Guide.
4. These prayers are intended to be a springboard to help you with your prayerful conversations. Trust the Holy Spirit to help you to expand upon the prayer that you are praying for the day. If you speak in tongues, please pray in tongues over each prayer topic. Relax, listen and enjoy the Lord.
5. Record any reflections, revelations, or inspiration given by the Holy Spirit in the Prayer Expectation section at the end of the Power Guide.
6. Believe that the Lord is hearing your prayer and know in your heart that your praying will produce God's results for the prayer topic for which you are praying.
7. After praying, make your daily power confession by using the Daily Power Confessions located on page (42). When you speak God's Word over your life, you activate the power of His Word to work in your life and produce God's results for your life. Expect God's Word to transform your life. I also recommend that you speak the Power Confessions over your family.
8. Enjoy your time spent with the Lord and thank you for helping to *"take the world by prayer."*

**Prayer Topic #1:**  
**A Prayer for Entrepreneurs**

**Scripture Reading:**  
Psalm 95, Psalm 1

**Reflections of the Heart:**

Godly entrepreneurs should be mindful of the seven things the Lord detests, which are haughty eyes, lying tongues, hands that kill the innocent, hearts that plot evil, feet that race to do wrong, false witnesses who pour out lies and persons who sows discord among brothers. As entrepreneurs, we should walk in Godly integrity, and our communities will reap the benefits.

**Scriptural Prayer:**

Father, You are God, and Your Word is true. We extol You as our God and King. We will bless Your Name forever and ever. We will bless You and praise Your Name each day. You are great and greatly to be praised. You are our source, and we place our trust in You. Thank You for providing for our entrepreneurs throughout the years. Thank You, Father, for blessing businesses within our community and opening doors of opportunity to produce profit and employment. Thank You for the economic development that we have in our community.

Lord, we confess Your Word to be operative in the lives of our entrepreneurs and the economic development of our community. We confess that our entrepreneurs are blessed, and we expect favor to surround Your people like a shield. We decree that as our entrepreneurs commit their works to You, their thoughts will be established. We declare that our entrepreneurs will honor You with their possessions and with the first fruits of all their increases so that their barns will be filled and their vats will overflow with new wine. We declare that whatever they do, they will do it heartily, as to You and not to men. Lord, we confess that as our entrepreneurs walk uprightly, no good thing will be withheld from them. We expect You to look upon the economic development in our community favorably and make our land fruitful. Father, as You continue to bless us, we will be a blessing to the entrepreneurs in our community by frequenting their businesses.

Holy Spirit, we ask that Your Spirit of wisdom, understanding, counsel, and power rest on each entrepreneur, investor and employee. Fill them with the knowledge of Your will, and give them a thirst for Your Word so that they can learn Your ways for practicing business. Holy Spirit, help them to make righteous decisions and operate with justice and integrity. Give them dreams and visions that exceed their expectations and provide new ideas to recreate themselves within the business world. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. ***(Take a moment and the Holy Spirit to reveal names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He reveals them, say, "I forgive name of person(s)." Now, trust the Lord to heal any wounds in your soul caused by unforgiveness.)***

Holy Spirit help us all not to yield to temptation but deliver them from the evil one.

Lord, You are the King of glory. You are the Lord of hosts. You are worthy to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

**Scriptural Prayer:**

Omniscient Father, we thank You for the United States of America. Thank You for our elected officials, first responders, public works employees and everyone who helps with the day-to-day operation of our nation. Thank You for the citizens of our great nation. You are great and greatly to be praised. You are to be feared above all gods. The earth is Yours and everything in it; the world and all its people belong to You. You laid the earth's foundation on the seas and built it on the ocean depths. Lord, Your works are wonderful. You are our hope and shield. In You, do our hearts rejoice because we trust in Your holy Name. Let Your unfailing love continue to surround us, Lord, for our hope is in You alone.

Mobilize and send us and other believers into our nation to share the Gospel, causing Your power to prevail throughout our nation. Holy Spirit, please unify our nation and help us all to stand for justice and righteousness. We ask that Your Spirit of wisdom, understanding, counsel, and power rest upon each political, civic and religious leader. Fill them with the knowledge of Your will and give them a thirst for Your Word so that they will walk in Your ways. Help them to make righteous decisions and operate with honesty and integrity. Lord, please bless the United States of America to be a beacon of light and hope for all nations of the world.

As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. ***(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He reveals them, say, "I forgive name of person(s)."*** Now, trust the Lord to heal any wounds in your soul caused by unforgiveness.)

Holy Spirit, help us all not to yield to temptation but deliver us from the evil one.

**Reflections of the Heart:**

Families come in a variety of sizes and dynamics. Whether you are single, a single parent, widowed, married with children or married without children; each family is an expression of God. Praise and thank God for your family.

**Scriptural Prayer:**

Heavenly Father, our souls honor You. Thank You for our family relationships. We thank You for peace umpiring our familial relationships and interactions. Lord, we thank You for fulfilling Your plans and purposes in our lives and for surrounding us with favor like a shield. Thank You for blessing us continually with Your loving-kindness and tender mercies. Your mercy endures forever. You are great and Your power is absolute. Your understanding is beyond comprehension. We love You and extol Your Holy Name. Out of the mouths of babes and infants, You have ordained strength. What are mere mortals that You should think of them, human beings that You should care for them?

Glorious Father, we declare that our families will live in peaceful habitations, in safe dwellings, and in quiet resting places. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive and help me to forgive. ***(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He reveals them, say, "I forgive name of person(s)." Now, trust the Lord to heal any wounds in your soul caused by unforgiveness.)***

Holy Spirit, help our families not to yield to temptation but deliver us from the evil one.

Sovereign Lord, You are King! You are robed in majesty and armed with strength. The world stands firm and cannot be shaken. Your throne has stood from time immemorial. You are from the everlasting past. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

**Scripture Reading:**

Psalm 91, Psalm 23

**Reflections of the Heart:**

This I declare about the Lord: He alone is my refuge, my place of safety; He is my God and I trust Him. – Psalm 91:2

**Scriptural Prayer:**

Exalted Father, we thank You for being in relationship with us. Thank You for Your perfect love, which casts out all fear. Thank You for being our Protector and Redeemer. Lord, all the earth will shout joyful praises to You and sing about the glory of Your Name. We will tell the world how glorious You are.

Almighty Father, although the public safety requirements of the COVID-19 pandemic dictate that all citizens stay at home extensively, we know that some homes are inhabited by people who commit domestic violence. We recognize that the stress of being confined to the same environment can trigger aggression in some offenders and cause them to lash out at others in their homes. We declare that You are the wall of fire that surrounds each victim of domestic violence. Your plans for their lives are for good and not evil, that they will each have a future and a hope. We rebuke the spirits of wrath, anger and violence in those who commit domestic violence. We command peace to be still in each home and relationship. We declare that victims of domestic violence will make You their refuge, Lord, and that You will give Your angels charge over them wherever they are.

***List the names of anyone the Holy Spirit brings to your mind while you are praying this prayer and commit to praying for them this month:***

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Worthy Father, please break the generational curses, strongholds and feelings of hopelessness and helplessness that lead to domestic violence. Lord, enable victims to recognize that You are with them and give them Your wisdom as they seek places to live where they can be safe from the abuse. Holy Spirit, please heal every emotional, physical and spiritual wound that has been inflicted upon the victims. Lead both the victim and the aggressor to the help they need to be healed and delivered.

Righteous Father, please forgive each man and woman who has inflicted physical, emotional or sexual assault on a loved one. Forgive our nation for turning a blind eye to domestic violence. Forgive our governmental officials for not passing laws to protect victims and help them recover and for not creating programs to rehabilitate offenders. Forgive family members and friends who make excuses for offenders and enable their abusive behavior. Lord, forgive me for ***(list any sins that you have committed)***. Holy Spirit, remind us all of those we need to forgive and help us to be quick to forgive. As for me, Holy Spirit, bring to my remembrance those I need to forgive. ***(Take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal names or faces of people that you may need to forgive. As He reveals them, say "I forgive name of person(s)." Now, trust the Lord to heal any wounds in your soul caused by unforgiveness.)***

Holy Spirit, help the victims and perpetrators of domestic violence not to yield to temptation but deliver them from the evil one.

Sovereign Lord, You are the Omnipotent, Omniscient, Omnipresent King, and we adore You. Glorious Lord, the earth is Yours and everything in it. The world and all its people belong to You. Open up, ancient gates! Open up, ancient doors, and let the King of glory enter. Who is the King of glory? The Lord of Heaven's Armies – He is the King of glory. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
